TAX APPOINTMENTS AT INTERSERV BEGIN JANUARY 16

INTERSERV CALVIN CENTER BECOMES PERMANENT HOME TO PROGRAM

St. Joseph, Mo. _ Interfaith Community Services - InterServ - will begin taking appointments for the Tax Counseling for the Elderly program on Wednesday, January 16.

Those wishing to have InterServ volunteers help with tax prep in 2019 may call (816) 558-3240 to leave contact information and get a return phone call with a confirmation of an appointment which will take place at the Calvin Center beginning February 1.

InterServ volunteers help area residents prepare Federal and State Income Tax forms as well as Missouri State Property Tax Credit and Rent Rebate forms. The Calvin Center, located at 1412 North 3rd Street in St. Joseph, will be used for InterServ volunteers to prepare taxes for seniors and property/rent rebate forms in 2019. The phone number is new to the program - 558-3240 - and will now be the number to create appointments for both tax prep and property/rent rebate. InterServ volunteers prepared 1,340 Federal, State and Property Tax Credit returns for elderly and low in-come persons in 2018 totaling \$1,027,889 in refunds.

In 2019, taxes will be prepared on Monday, Wednesday, Friday and every other Saturday starting at 9:00 am beginning February 1. Property Tax Credit and Rent Rebate forms will be prepared on Tuesday and Thursday starting at 9:00 am. The last day for the program is Monday, April 15.

The tax office entrance is located on the West side of the Calvin Center and we ask those who attend an appointment to park in the upper lot that is located off of East Rosine Street. Overflow parking will be in the lower lot next to North 3rd Street.
